The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.31 dated 15.03.2019, under Sections 379, 379-B, 411, 392 and 482 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Division No.4, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR was registered on the basis of secret information that the petitioner and others had formed gang for looting and robbing the passersby. He also contends that from the petitioner, 05 mobile phones were recovered. Petitioner is 22 years old and has been falsely implicated in the case. The petitioner is in custody for over seven months. He further contends that after the arrest of the petitioner in the instant case, he was implicated in another case.

Learned State counsel states that although charges have been framed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 22 years of age, he is in custody for over seven months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
