Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 207 dated 12.04.2017 registered under Sections 148, 149 and 302 of IPC, at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that present FIR was registered on the complaint of Suresh Kumar s/o Moti Ram, wherein it was alleged that his son Vikas, aged about 18 years, was found injured in the house of the present petitioner-Jodha Ram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also drawn the attention of this Court to the statement of the complainant-Suresh Kumar, who has appeared before the learned trial Court on 28.02.2018, in which he has stated that his son had met with an accident at village Shekhopura and while shifted

to Government Hospital, Karnal for the treatment, where he passed away.

This factum has not been disputed by the learned State counsel and informed that the case is at fag end. Out of 16 witnesses 13 witnesses has been examined.

Without commenting anything on the merits lest it should prejudice the case either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
