TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner seeks a mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect his life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 11.

Counsel would submit that petitioner had entered into an agreement to sell dated 25.09.2013 with respondents No.5 and 8 for purchase of house and Rs.15,00,000/- has been paid as earnest money.

It is urged that thereafter the petitioner became aware that the property in question is belonging to somebody else and on the basis of forged and false documents, the petitioner has been induced to enter into such agreement.

The pleadings on record are not sufficient for this Court to infer any immediate and imminent threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Insofar as the agreement to sell that is stated to have been entered into by the petitioner with respondents No.5 and 8, it would always be open for the petitioner to pursue his civil remedies in accordance with

law.

No directions are required to be passed.
