GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

At the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and to apply for grant of regular bail and also to move an application for grant of interim bail on medical grounds since the petitioner has been diagnosed to be having polycystic disease involving the kidneys and liver.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In case the petitioner chooses to surrender before the trial Court within a period of two weeks from today and applies for grant of regular bail, the learned trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously. Further in case any application seeking grant of interim bail on medical grounds is filed, the trial Court shall consider the same expeditiously and dispose of the same at the earliest, preferably within 2

days from filing of such application, after seeking verification regarding the medical condition of the petitioner from the local hospital.

It is clarified that in case the medical report is obtained prior to 2 days, the trial Court would be at liberty to take up the bail immediately upon receipt of such report and to dispose of the same.
