Prayer in the instant petition is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to step-up the pay of the petitioners at par with their juniors.

At the very outset, learned State counsel submits that the claim of the petitioners has been considered in the light of the Punjab Government instructions dated 13.10.2014 (Annexure P-1) and accordingly, their pay has been stepped up at par with their juniors vide office orders dated 18.06.2018 and 06.07.2018 (Annexures R-2 colly.). It is further submitted that the petitioners shall also be entitled to arrears for the period of 38 months from the date of submission of application.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners does not dispute the aforesaid fact situation.

In view of the above, considering the fact that necessary decision has been taken vide Annexure R-2, the respondents are directed to

release the consequential relief, expeditiously.

Disposed of accordingly.
