Prayer in this application is for issuance of a writ of *mandamus* directing the Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Mukeria – respondent No.2 to proceed with the partition proceedings in the light of the remand order passed by the Appellate Authority, which has been upheld upto the Financial Commissioner, as the grievance of the petitioners was that the case of partition is not being proceeded with.

Perusal of the affidavit filed by the Tehsildar, Mukerian, dated 11.04.2019, would indicate that proceedings before the Assistant Collector 1st Grade, are in progress.
