The petitioner has approached this Court seeking release of detenues namely Jyoti, Poorab, Parmeet Kaur, Sovinder, Sapna, Sanjana, Khushi, Mathu, Dhir Singh, Rani, Gunjan, Vansh, Ritika, Sanjay, Pinki, Honey, Gollo, Munna, Gaje Singh, Rajo, Sachin and Sonia, stated to be illegally detained.

At this stage Mr. Shiva Khurmi, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5 and filed power of attorney. The same is taken on record.

Pursuant to order dated 15.7.2019, passed by this Court, a Warrant Officer visited the premises in question i.e. brick kiln under the name and style PBT situated in Village Manakpur Sharif, Tehsil, Kharar, Police Station Majri, District SAS Nagar, Punjab, and has reported that the alleged detenues were roaming freely and were not found to be guarded by

anyone and at that time and there was no such situation like illegal detention. It has also been reported that the said detenues however did not wish to work there and wanted to leave the premises and that the owner of the brick kiln was not having any objection for their leaving the brick kiln and thereafter all the detenues left the premises of brick kiln along with their belongings.

In view of the aforestated report, no further direction is required to be issued. The writ petition is dismissed, having rendered infructuous.
