Today, at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and to apply for grant of regular bail.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the learned Trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of 4 days from filing of such application while taking into account all the pleas raised herein on behalf of the petitioner, including his specific plea to the effect that in fact the injured had been making advances towards his wife and that the incident occurred when the petitioner’s wife disclosed about the same to the petitioner.
