This order shall dispose of the aforementioned two petitions as both of them have been filed by petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest in common FIR No.141 dated

22.12.2018 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women, Patiala.

However, for convenience and clarity, detailed order is being passed in **CRM-M-29926 of 2019**.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the matter has been compromised between the parties and on the basis of compromise, a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has been filed, wherein statements on first motion have already been recorded and the statements on second motion are to be recorded on 20.03.2020.

Accordingly, the present petitions are disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioners are required in any manner, they shall be served a prior notice of 15 days, so that they can avail the appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
