Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 118, dated 01.06.2019, registered under Sections 323, 325, 326, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

The learned counsel for petitioner states that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case on account of certain business dealings with complainant.

Vide order dated 17.07.2019, this Court, while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail, directed the petitioner to join the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ajmer Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above, petition is allowed. The order dated 17.07.2019, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
