The petitioner filed a Criminal Miscellaneous No.M-29667 of 2018 raising a grievance that respondents no. 6 and 7 (in the criminal petition) have allegedly embezzled the Panchayat funds. The petition was disposed of on 17.7.2018 directing the respondent No.3 (in the criminal petition) to consider the representation dated 11.6.2018 and in case it is revealed that the petitioner needed some protection, action be taken in accordance with law within eight weeks.

The present petition is filed pleading that needful has not been done. Short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Vivek Sheel Soni, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, filed today in Court is taken on record and copy supplied to counsel for petitioner.

In the affidavit it is pleaded that due inquiry has been conducted on the representation and vigilance inquiry is being conducted. The concerned persons have been called in the office of Director, Vigilance Bureau, Chandigarh vide letter dated 6.12.2019. It is further pleaded that no threat perception was found to the life and liberty of the petitioner and moreover the petitioner himself made a statement before the SP (OPS),

Ferozepur that he does not need any security now.

The said facts are not contradicted by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the pleadings and reply filed, no further interference is called for.

The contempt petition is dismissed.
