As per pleading on record both the petitioners have attained the age of majority and are staying together in a live in relationship. Both the petitioners are stated to be married earlier elsewhere but on account of differences and misunderstanding have left their respective partners.

Instant writ petition has been filed seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to take necessary steps for protection of life and liberty by voicing an apprehension of threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.3 confined to the aspect of threat to their life.

In the eventuality of any application being filed, respondent No.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
