The writ petition, filed by the petitioners claiming pension in view of the judgment passed in *CWP No. 18381 of 2003* titled as *Davinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another*, decided on 19.04.2010, was disposed of on 07.01.2019. The Court without expressing opinion on the merits of the case, directed the respondent to decide the legal notice dated 18.07.2018. Needful was to be done within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The contempt petition is filed pleading that the needful has not been done.

Reply dated 13.11.2019 filed by way of short affidavit of Sh. Kanwalpreet Brar, IAS, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana is taken on record. A copy is handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioners.

Along with reply, order dated 30.07.2019 is annexed wherein the claim of the petitioner has been rejected.

Unconditional apology is tendered by the learned counsel for the respondent for the delay in complying the order. The same is accepted.

In view of the order passed, there is compliance of the directions passed by this Court. No interference is called for. The contempt petition is disposed of. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against order dated 30.07.2019.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
