Petitioner has filed the present writ petition for the grant of benefit of ACP after completion of 4 years and 9 years service.

During the course of hearing today, counsel for the respondents have produced an order dated 26.04.2018, by which the benefit, as being claimed in the present writ petition, has already been allowed to the petitioner and even the arrears on account of said benefit have also been released to her. The relevant documents have been supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner express ignorance about the passing of the said order and the grant of the said benefit to the petitioner.

Once the respondents have made a statement and has produced the order including voucher vide which the payment was made to the petitioner, the statement cannot be disbelieved.
