The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.55 dated 12.04.2019, under Sections 420, 120-B, 467, 468, 472, 474 & 475 IPC, registered at Police Station Sarangpur, District Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner was preparing forged Aadhaar cards by using fake stamps and other documents. He further contends that recovery of the documents has been effected from the co-accused namely Bimlesh and no recovery has been effected from the petitioner. He is not involved in any other case. He is in custody since 13.04.2019.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from Inspector Virinder Singh, states that 2 out of 12 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for 5 months and 4 days, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
