**HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.(ORAL)**

In the present writ petition, the claim of the petitioner is for the grant of pensionary benefits after his retirement i.e. 31.10.2013.

Learned counsel for the respondents, at the outset, states that the benefits for which the petitioner is entitled for, have already been released to him.

On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner had requested for time to seek instructions from the petitioner in respect of the dates on which the petitioner had received the amount so as to claim interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as he has not been able to contact the petitioner, petitioner be given liberty to file an appropriate representation with the respondents to claim interest and further that the said representation be decided expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the respondents, on the other hand, states that in case any representation is received claiming interest from the

petitioner, the same will be decided expeditiously within a period of three months from the receipt of the same and an appropriate order will be passed on the same keeping in view the settled principle of law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no further grievance of the petitioner subsists and he does not press the writ petition any further.

The writ petition is disposed of as having been not pressed, at this stage.
