In the present writ petition, charge sheet dated 24.07.2015
(Annexure P/7) is under challenge.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has brought to the notice of
this Court that an order dated 25.10.2019 is passed by the respondents, vide
which the charge sheet dated 24.07.2015 has been dropped.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same and
