It has been pleaded that the petitioner had submitted an application dated 17.10.2017 before the competent authority for issuance of an Arms license.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that till date the application has not been processed and neither has the Arms license been issued nor declined.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Siddharth Sanwaria, learned DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and waives service. Complete copy of the writ paper book already stands furnished to learned State counsel.

Statement of learned State counsel is recorded to the effect that in case the application dated 17.10.2017 seeking issuance of an Arms license is still pending with the District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Panipat, the same would be processed in accordance with law and under the provisions of the Arms Act, 1959 read with Rules framed thereunder and a

final decision would be taken and communicated to the petitioner within a period of two months from today.

In the light of such statement recorded on behalf of the State, no further directions are required to be passed.

Writ petition is disposed of.
