GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

The learned counsel submits that the petitioner is an Ex.-Sarpanch of Village Noor Talai and is presently a 'Lambardar'. It has been submitted that a 'Dharamshala' had been constructed in the village Noor Talai out of the Panchayat funds, but now respondents No.7 to 11, who have nothing to do with the Panchayat, have taken forcible possession of the said 'Dharamshala'. The learned counsel has further submitted that the Panchayat had also passed a resolution (Annexure P-1) for taking action against the trespassers for illegal possession and the matter had also been reported to the police vide representation dated 2.5.2019 (Annexure P-3), but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on merits of case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 2.5.2019 (Annexure

P-3), moved by petitioner, in accordance with law, at the earliest. In case the allegations levelled therein are found to be well founded, then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 2.5.2019 (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, so as to enable him to do the needful at the earliest.
