In the present writ petition, the grievance which the petitioner raising is against the Punjab State Cooperative Bank and Gurdaspur Central Cooperative Bank for directions to them to release the benefits.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 to 3 argues that the present writ petition is not maintainable before this Court. Keeping in view, the order passed by this Court in CWP No. 6776 of 1999 titled as Ranjit Singh Versus The Registrar Cooperative Societies, Punjab, Chandigarh and another, decided on 31.08.2010, wherein the Punjab State Cooperative Bank has been held not to be amenable to the writ jurisdiction of this Court.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays to allow him to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to have his remedy before the appropriate authority under the provisions of the

Cooperative Societies Act, 1961.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
