AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court challenging the order dated 30.01.2018 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Bhiwani, vide which respondent No. 3-Sombir son of Rajinder Kumar has been appointed as Chowkidar in Village Naloi, Tehsil Shivani, District Bhiwani.

It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that respondent No. 3-Sombir has encroached upon the land which is *gair mumkin Gali* and, therefore, he being in an illegal possession of the Government land cannot be appointed as a Chowkidar of the village. He, thus, contends that the impugned order cannot sustain.

I have considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and with his assistance, have gone through the impugned order and the records.

As is apparent from the order, which has been passed by the

Collector, Bhiwani dated 30.01.2018 (Annexure P-4) that educational qualification of the candidates have been taken into consideration. Merits and demerits of the candidates have also been assessed. Allegation with regard to respondent No. 3 being in illegal unauthorized possession of the Government land also has not been established. The competent authority has taken every aspect into consideration and has found no merit with regard to the allegation of the illegal possession/encroachment on Govt. land.

Finding no merit in the present writ petition, the same stands dismissed.
