Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.93 dated 26.04.2018 under Sections 363, 366-A, 212, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that main accused in the case is Sukhveer Singh @ Bulia, who enticed away the daughter of the complainant, who is aged about 13-14 years and is a student of 8th class. The allegation against the petitioner is that he has given shelter to the main accused. Petitioner is in custody since 17.04.2019.

Learned State Counsel states that the petitioner has been arrayed as an accused and has given protection to main accused Sukhveer Singh @ Bulia and Sapna. She further states that even whereabouts of the girl are not known till today.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 17.04.2019, the allegation if any is against co-accused Sukhveer Singh @ Bulia, who has allegedly enticed away the daughter of the complainant and trial in the case is not likely to be concluded in the near future, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

However, it is made clear that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and the trial Court shall proceed with the trial independently without being influenced by the order of bail passed by this Court.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall not extend any threat and shall not try to influence any prosecution witnesses directly or indirectly in any manner.
