AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 30.1.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 1944 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 4 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the above said representation (P-5) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, competent authorities come to the conclusion that petitioner is entitled to the relief(s) claimed, same be released to him within a period of next one month. At the time of disbursement of the said amount, respondent No. 4 shall also be oblized to consider the grant of interest on the delayed payments in the light of judgment passed by

Short reply dated 29.8.2019 by way of affidavit of Jiwan Kumar Garg, Tehsildar, Sangrur filed in court today is taken on record. Copy thereof has been given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the reply, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition as directions of this Court have been complied with.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
