Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner, in FIR No.1682 dated 28.11.2017, under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station City Jagadhari.

On 17.07.2019, while issuing notice of motion, this Court has passed the following order:-

“Notice of motion for 13.09.2019.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Dal Singh, has stated that in terms of order dated 17.07.2019, the petitioner has joined investigation and her custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, order dated 17.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off, accordingly.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
