Petitioner Vikas Kumar @ Rinku has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.135 dated 04.05.2019, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Sirsa, District Sirsa, under Sections 195A/294/506/509 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for the complainant have appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

The complainant of this case had earlier got registered FIR under Section 376 IPC etc. in which the present petitioner was on anticipatory bail. Now, the allegation in the present petition is that the petitioner is threatening the complainant and putting pressure upon him to

compromise in the earlier case under Section 376 IPC etc.

The petitioner has been in custody since 04.05.2019. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
