Prayer in the petition is to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 147 dated 02.07.2019 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been nominated on the basis of statement of Chowkidar who has now given an affidavit and is also present in the Court and states that he never identified the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Poonam Chand, has submitted that huge quantity of 25,000 intoxicating tablets were recovered from the car which was purchased by the petitioner on 09.05.2019 and had also applied for transfer of the same in his name.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court does not find ground to grant concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
