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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 231, dated 3.7.2019, registered under Sections 489B, 489C IPC at Police Station Old Faridabad.

As per allegations in FIR, 48 currency notes of denomination of Rs. 200/- were recovered from Lakshay Sethi. It was during interrogation that said Lakshay Sethi disclosed that he had been supplied currency notes by petitioner.

The contention of learned counsel for petitioner is that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case.

Vide order dated 25.7.2019, this Court, while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail, directed petitioner to join investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Azad Singh, states that petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of above, petition is allowed. The order dated 25.7.2019, granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioner, is made absolute. However, petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
