GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.214, dated 18.6.2018, registered at Police Station Murthal, District Sonapat, under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 and 34 IPC, and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 19.7.2019 the parties had been directed to appear before the Trial Court so as to get the statements recorded.
3. Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sonapat, has been received wherein it has been reported that statement of complainant Leena as well as of petitioners/accused Bharat Sharma and Sharvan Kumar, have been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a

compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainant has specifically stated that the matter has been compromised with the petitioner and she does not want to pursue with the matter. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sonapat, opined that the compromise is genuine.

4. In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.214, dated 18.6.2018, registered at Police Station Murthal, District Sonapat, under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 and 34 IPC, and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
