This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to take action on the inquiry report dated 06.10.2017 (Annexure P-2) submitted by respondent No.3 against respondent No.4.

Perused.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr. Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl.A.G., Punjab in the Court today.

Without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director, Rural Development and Panchayat Department, Punjab to consider and decide the representation dated 23.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) within six

weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the request made by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the request made by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
