This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to promote the petitioner as Lecturer (School Cadre) from the date her juniors have been promoted.

Learned State counsel, at the very outset, states that the Department is in the process of preparing a fresh seniority list.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if her claim for seniority be also considered by the Committee.

Heard.

In this view of the matter, the petitioner, if so advised, may

make a representation to the Committee to consider her claim for seniority as well. In case, on consideration, the petitioner is found to be placed on the seniority list as per record, the same be assigned to her expeditiously and an opportunity of hearing be also afforded to her. The necessary exercise be completed with six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this judgment. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
