The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the respondents to conduct a fair and proper investigation in FIR No.27 dated 19.03.2019 under Sections 342, 376 and 506 IPC registered at Women Police Station, Palwal.

Prayer has also been made for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to hand over investigation of the case to some other independent agency other than Haryana Police and to arrest the accused.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the paper book, it reveals that the matter is being investigated by the police. The status report dated 03.06.2019 (Annexure P-7) shows that the statement of prosecutrix under Section 164 Cr.PC has already been recorded. The site of occurrence has been investigated and site plan has been prepared. Even the crime team was called at the spot of occurrence and verification was got done

from the SHO and Deputy Superintendent of Police. In order to arrest the accused, necessary help of cyber cell was also taken and even a Special Investigation Team (SIT) has been constituted in compliance of the directions issued by the Additional Director General of Police, Rewari Range.

Therefore, this Court finds that after registration of the FIR on 19.03.2019, when the police is investigating the matter, no ground to interfere in the investigation is made out.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
