Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the respondents have wrongly declined to entertain the petition which was filed by the petitioner on the ground of non-maintainability. Counsel for the petitioner argues that RSA No. 1748 of 1989 was also dismissed by this Court on the ground of non-maintainability of the petition under Section 55 of the Punjab Cooperative Societies Act, 1961 and the said order has been stayed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly states that these facts were not brought to the notice of the authorities, while passing the impugned order. He prays that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the respondents in this regard.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
