Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.59 dated 03.04.2019, registered under Sections 324, 323, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), at Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that even as per the FIR, petitioner was possessed of a wooden stick and, therefore, injury under Section 326 IPC is not attributable to the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner is in custody for 1 month and 18 days. He further submits that injured was discharged from the hospital within 5 days.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State has submitted that investigations are in progress and final report shall be presented before

the Court as early as possible.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody, not involved in any other case, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
