The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (in short, “Cr.P.C”) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.43 dated 1.2.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 363, 366-A of Indian Penal Code (for short, “IPC”) at Police Station City, Hansi.

Heard.

Learned counsel for petitioner has placed reliance on the statement of the prosecutrix (Annexure P-6) recorded under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure wherein she has stated that she has herself left the house and the petitioner met her on the railway station. Both of them had gone to Jaipur by train and nobody has pressurized her to go there. She has returned by her own.

The petitioner is in custody since 3.12.2018.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Sandeep son of Babu Lal is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
