The petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that the full information, as sought for and is directed by the State Information Commission, has not been supplied to the petitioner.

During the course of hearing, certain documents were supplied to the petitioner.

Today, counsel for the petitioner has asserted that he has not been supplied the full copy of the manual of instructions of service matters, Volume III. He, therefore, contends that circular letter dated 22.08.1989, as supplied by the respondents, is incomplete.

Another assertion, which was put forth by counsel for the petitioner was that the appointment letter of Harbhajan Singh son of

Balwant Singh, Village and Post Office Dhappai, Tehsil and District Faridkot, has not been supplied.

This was the situation at the first round of hearing and the case was kept to be taken up at 12.15 P.M. Now the complete copy of the manual of instructions on service matters, Volume III, has been handed over to counsel for the petitioner. Alongwith the said manual, attested copy of the appointment letter, as was appended with the affidavit dated 20.11.2018, Annexure R-3, has been supplied. It has further been stated by counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mr.Rajiv Kumar, Clerk, office of Director, Public Instructions (S.E.), Punjab, Chandigarh, that these are based upon the original records available with the Department.

In the light of the above and keeping in view the fact that the attested copies of the documents have been supplied to counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
