Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
seeking bail pending trial in case FIR No. 68 dated 02.05.2019, under
Sections 452, 326, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections
325 and 450 of IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station
Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the role
attributed to the petitioner is that he has given danda blow on the left
side of the back of complainant, which is on the non vital part of the
body. Further contends that the matter has been compromised between
the parties and the petitioner is in custody since 31.05.2019 . Also
contends that challan has not yet been presented, therefore, prays for

release of the petitioner on regular bail.

Learned counsel for the complainant has duly acknowledged the factum of compromise.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper book.

Keeping in view the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties and challan has not been presented till date, thus the trial is likely to take a long time to be concluded, as such no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars any more.

Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is accepted. Petitioner-Bishan Singh be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, it is made clear that the disposal of the present petition may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case pending before learned trial Court.
