Petitioner seeks a mandamus for directing the official respondents to take necessary steps for protection of his life and liberty as also his property by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.6 to 9.

Insofar as the property is concerned, it would be open for the petitioner to take recourse of his civil remedies in accordance with law.

Insofar as protection of life and liberty is concerned, the pleadings on record are insufficient for this Court to infer any imminent danger to his life and liberty.

No further directions are required to be passed.

Petition dismissed.
