Prayer in the instant petition is for quashing of order dated 09.03.2009 (Annexure P-3), passed by respondent No.4, whereby, Circular No.40/2004 (Annexure P-2), issued by respondent No.1 has been implemented at the Rajpura Goods Shed without providing the necessary infrastructure.

There is no assistance on behalf of the petitioner.

Reply on behalf of the respondents filed in the Court, is taken on record. A perusal of the reply reveals that all the facilities like flood lights and other infrastructure including approach roads, drinking water, merchant room, rest rooms for the labour working there, covered sheds for goods consignment, toilet and bathing facilities for labour and boundary walls, etc. have been provided. It is further submitted that the department has already allotted the execution of repair work and largely the work has

been completed, however, due to excessive rains, certain approach roads are yet to be laid. The same shall be completed without further delay.

In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
