Petitioner-Sandeep Kumar has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.446 dated 20.11.2018, under Section 304-B/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

Petitioner is the husband who was married with the deceased in December, 2016. The deceased-wife has died on 20.11.2018. There are allegations against the petitioner and her family members that deceased was taunted for bringing less dowry. About six months before her death the accused demanded Rs.1 lakh and for not giving the same, she was turned out of the house. The complainant gave Rs. 50,000/- and thereafter the Panchayat left the deceased at her in-laws house. Thereafter there was a demand for a car and on her refusal to satisfy their demand, she was given beatings.

The petitioner is the husband and there are serious allegations against him. The argument of counsel for the petitioner that the mother-in-law and father-in-law have been granted bail is no ground to grant bail to the petitioner as he is the husband and there are serious allegations against him.

Petition is dismissed.
