The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 12.11.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 28543 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“As such, without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without going into the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to examine the representation dated 17.8.2019 (Annexure P-8) that is stated to have already been submitted and to thereafter take action thereupon as deemed fit and warranted in accordance with law.

Let a final decision on the representation at Annexure P-8 be taken within a period of 8 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and the same be

conveyed to the petitioner.”

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced order dated 15.3.2019 in court. The same is taken on record, copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per the said order, the claim of the petitioner has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against order dated 15.3.2019.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
