The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 118 dated 18.06.2019, under Sections 3, 4 and 5 of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is based on secret information that the petitioners are indulging in immoral trafficking and if their premises are raided, they along with other persons can be apprehended. The petitioners were not present when the raid was conducted. The petitioners are not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 18.07.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gurtej Singh, states the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 18.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
