CWP-15242-2018

This is a petition directed against the order dated 19.3.2018

(Annexure P-10) passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Patiala (respondent No. 2), by which he has cancelled the allotment of 5-5 marla plot made in favour of petitioners vide letter dated 01.06.2016.

Learned counsel for respondents No. 6 to 13 (impleaded today) has submitted that they had made a complaint that the plots have been allotted to more than one member of the family. He has further submitted that in the inquiry report of the SDM, Samana which has been relied upon by the petitioners is a preliminary report but no final report has been prepared after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners and other share holders.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties. The order dated 19.3.2018 passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Patiala (respondent No. 2) is kept in abeyance and a direction is issued to the SDM, Samana to submit the final inquiry report to the Deputy Commissioner, Patiala (respondent No. 2) after affording an opportunity of hearing to the parties concerned. The entire proceedings shall be carried out and completed by the SDM, Samana within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
