Petitioner seeks a mandamus for directing the official respondents to release in his favour the incentive subsidy of Rs.30,72,500/- as per sanctioned letter dated 24.11.2000 (Annexure P-1).

It is the case of the petitioner that inspite of repeated reminders/representation, the capital subsidy amount as noticed hereinabove, has not been released.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Ambika Sood, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and a complete copy of the writ paper-book already stands furnished to learned State counsel.

Statement of Ms. Ambika Sood, DAG, Punjab, is recorded to the effect that the matter would be examined and either the admissible capital subsidy would be released to the petitioner as per seniority or if the petitioner is found not entitled to the same a speaking order in such regard would be passed and conveyed to him.

In view of the statement recorded of learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be passed.

Writ petition disposed of.
