The present revision petition is filed against the order dated 20.5.2019, vide which the trial Court dismissed the application for framing of fresh issues.

A perusal of the application filed before the trial Court shows that the petitioner while praying for framing of fresh issues did not mention as to which issue was required to be framed. Hence, the Court had no opportunity to know whether the said issue was similar to the issue already framed or was in any way different or whether fresh issue was required to be framed at all in view of the earlier issues also covering the fresh issue. Hence, no interference is called for.

The revision petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to file a fresh application before the trial Court with the detail of the fresh issue that is required to be framed. In case, the application is filed, the same shall be decided in accordance with law.
