ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.195 dated 27.11.2018 under Sections 395/201 IPC, registered at Police Station Garhi, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations against the petitioners in the FIR are that they alongwith co-accused had snatched the purse of the complainant containing ₹49,820/-. Recovery of ₹4500/- each is alleged to have been effected from the petitioners. They are in custody for almost 6 months since their arrest on 29.11.2018. Petitioner No.1 is 22 years of age while petitioner No.2 is 21 years of age. He further contends that petitioners were not involved in any other case and after their arrest in this case, they have been implicated in another case although they are not named in the FIR. He also contends that co-accused Pritam @ Ritu has been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-13262-2019 on 30.05.2019.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar states that 05 out of 14 prosecution witnesses have been examined. He states that the petitioners were also involved in another case. However, he is not in a position to controvert the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners that it was after their arrest in this case that they were arraigned as an accused in the other case.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners especially when they are in custody for almost 8 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
