Petitioner raises a challenge to the order dated 17.5.2019 (Annexure P-8) and in terms of which request of the petitioner to grant personal security cover, has been declined.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

Petitioner had projected himself to be the State General Secretary Punjab of the Bahujan Samaj Party having contested elections of Member of Parliament from Bathinda Parliamentary Constituency held in 2014. It is averred that he has also contested assembly elections from assembly constituency Sardulgarh, District Mansa held in the year 2012. Case projected is that being the General Secretary of Bahujan Samaj Party Punjab he is obligated to attend and address the meetings and rallies in the villages and it is very risky for the petitioner to attend such types of meetings.

Perusal of the impugned order dated 17.5.2019 (Annexure P-8) issued by the A.I.G./Security, Punjab would reveal that the latest threat perception has been appraised and there are no current inputs indicating any specific or imminent threat to the security of the petitioner.

There would be no occasion for this Court to take a different view on the subject.

No intervention is called for.

Petition is dismissed.
