Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.75 dated 20.03.2019 under Section 304-A of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 and 4 of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 Police Station Beas, District Amritsar.

Learned State counsel has informed the Court that in fact challan under Section 304 of the Indian Penal Code has been presented.

Precise allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner was awarded a contract for cleaning of sewerage in Sohan Cooperative Society. The allegations are that there was an agreement between Nagar Panchayat and the petitioner that no individual shall be permitted to go in the sewer. However, the petitioner violated the condition and sent two persons namely, late Sh. Vijay Partap Singh and Suresh Kumar, who unfortunately died.

The investigation is complete and the challan has been

presented. The petitioner is now in judicial custody and he is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
