This order shall dispose off first regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C in a case bearing FIR No.0023 dated 05.04.2019 filed under Sections 306 and 54 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station GRP Ambala Cantt.

The allegations against the present petitioner-Satish have been levelled by complainant-Rajo Devi, mother of deceased, Lalita, alleging that on 05.04.2019, his son-in-law-Sultan Singh informed her that his wife was not traceable and subsequently, on search, it transpired that she committed

suicide by jumping before the train.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and that the only allegations have come about two months' prior to the present occurrence and that there is no element of abetment to suicide from the investigations and the evidence gathered during the same and that the petitioner is behind the bars for almost more than 02 months.

On behalf of the State, the learned State counsel, assisted by SI Joginder Singh, Police Station GRP Ambala Cantt., has conceded to the factual scenario brought to the notice of this Court but has opposed the grant of the bail on the ground of heinousness of the offences.

Appreciating the arguments, the petitioner is behind the bars since long time and there are no direct allegations against the petitioner that has come up which has resulted in compelling the deceased to take such a step, thus, culpability, if any, shall be determined at the time of trial, this Court is of the opinion that it would serve no useful purpose to further detain the petitioner in custody. Accordingly, he is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate of the Court concerned.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
