The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is a matrimonial discord between Rajiv Kumar i.e. son of petitioners No.1 and 2 with his wife i.e. respondent No.5-Sonia Devi and on account of said matrimonial discord respondent No.5 with the help of respondent No.4-Station House Officer, Police Station Purana Salla, District Gurdaspur is trying to unnecessarily harass the petitioners so as to pressurize them to enter into some compromise. It has been submitted that the petitioners at the instance of respondent No.5 are being called to the police station time and again and made to sit there entire day long.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without commenting anything on the merits of the case as regards the allegations, the petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioners are required to be associated in connection with any inquiry or any information is to be elicited from them in respect of any criminal case in

respect of matrimonial discord as noticed above, then a prior written notice not less than four days be served upon them before summoning them.
