Petitioner has sought the relief of arrears of salary on the ground that on earlier occasion, services of the petitioner were terminated w.e.f. 31.03.2016 and approached this Court vide CWP No.7227 of 2016. This Court, vide order dated 02.08.2018, allowed the writ petition and directed the respondents to re-instate him, but he was not allowed to join duties within the period specified in the order.

I am afraid that the aforementioned relief cannot be granted as this Court did not grant the relief of consequential benefits in the previous writ petition. Petitioner is estopped to claim the relief. Petitioner wants to volte-face and rake up the issue again. No ground for interference is made out. Resultantly, the writ petition is dismissed.
